Library Looks Back at Studebaker Buildings

South Bend—*Studebaker: One Final Look*, an evocative display of Lou Sabo's black-and-white photographs of the old Studebaker factory buildings, is now available for viewing in the Local & Family History Department on the second floor of the St. Joseph County Public Library's Main Library, located at 304 S. Main Street in downtown South Bend.

These recent images of the ghostly remnants of South Bend's most famous factory were commissioned by the Historic Preservation Commission of St. Joseph County and are on temporary loan from that agency. The display, curated by John Kovach, will remain up through Valentine's Day.
